

24th Annual Great Lakes Pharmacy Resident Conference

April 30-May 1, 2009 in West Lafayette, Indiana

Overview: The Great Lake Pharmacy Resident Conference provides an opportunity for pharmacy residents from Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, and Wisconsin to meet and present research data. This conference offers an excellent opportunity for current pharmacy leaders to network with future pharmacy leaders. Please see www.glprc.com for the agenda and more information.

Target Audience: Each resident and at least one preceptor from pharmacy practice residency programs within the Great Lake region are expected to attend this conference. Specialty residents and preceptors are also encouraged to attend.

Conference Objectives:

Active participation in this conference should enable one to:

1. Identify significant pharmacy residency projects that are occurring at institutions within the Great Lakes region.
2. Develop professional contacts at other institutions within the Great Lakes region.
3. Incorporate new information presented at this conference into daily practice.

In addition to the conference goals listed above, each resident provides individual learning objectives and assessment questions. We estimate that there will be approximately 300 residents presenting at this conference.

Registrations received prior to March 1, 2009 qualify for a discounted registration fee of \$100.00. The fee for registrations received after March 1, 2009 is \$200.00. Registration fees are transferable, but not refundable. The registration fee includes meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner on Thursday as well as breakfast and lunch on Friday), audiovisual equipment rental, meeting room fees, and continuing education credit. The registration fee does not include hotel accommodations.



Continuing Education Credit: This conference qualifies for a minimum of .25 hour and up to 12.5 hours of continuing education credit in each category.
